GENERAL SUMMARY

Shigezo SUNOHARA, Dec'd.

Shigezo SUNOHARA died at Kaslo on January 1, 1944, at fifty-nine years of age. He was survived by his widow, Kesa, file #7587, and two sons, Fujio, file #15234, and Isao, file #7586.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian and none are revealed on the file other than a refund of 1½ wage deduction received from the Provincial Collector and credited to his account in the sum of \$5.50.

No claims appear on this file.

On November 20, 1945, Custodian cheque for the sum of \$5.50 was forwarded to Shigezo SUNOHARA at 411 Connolly Street, Fort William, Ontario, by registered mail. According to the Cheque Register and the cancelled cheque this cheque was cashed in December, 1945, by someone signing themselves "S. Sunohara". From the writing, it appears to have been the younger son, Isao, as the endorsement closely resembles his signature as witness on the declaration of his father. In view of the small amount involved, nothing is being done by this office.

At the time the cheque was forwarded no notification had been received by this office of the death of Shigezo SUNOHARA and the address to which the cheque was addressed must have been supplied to this office by the R. C. M. F.
