PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

June 23, 1947.

Re: Mr. Kiyosada FUJII, Reg. No. 68767

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on October 11th, 1943. He had been evacuated on February 23rd, 1942.

The only property of any kind reported by Mr. FUJII was one trunk containing books and other personal effects at the Japanese Hall, Chemainus, B. C. There is no record that an inventory of the contents of this Hall was made at any time. Shipments were made from the Hall to various Japanese early in the summer of 1942 but there is no evidence that a shipment was made to Mr. FUJII at that time or at any time since. On November 11th, 1943 all goods remaining at Chemainus considered to be of any value were shipped to Nanaimo where saleable articles were sold at auction. No goods identified as belonging to this man were among the personal effects shipped to Vancouver from Nanaimo after the completion of auction sales at Nanaimo. In letter of May 10th, 1947 Mr. FUJII requested shipment of his trunk. From this it would appear that he could not have taken it with him. It would seem that this trunk must be considered to be missing.

Mr. FUJII declared no other property of any kind whatsoever and no property of any kind other than that mentioned above is revealed by his file.

This file reveals no liabilities.

Your letter of May 10th requesting shipment of your home-made trunk has been received.

We regret very much to inform you that there is no record of a trunk identified as your property having been found at Chemainus.

All the goods of saleable value that remained at Chemainus in November, 1943, were sold at auction. Among the articles sold were some which carried no identification. It is possible that your goods may have been among these articles. If you would let us know in detail the contents of your trunk we shall investigate the matter further. For your convenience in replying we enclose a stamped addressed envelope.
