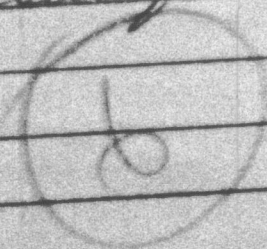


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

This 28-year old Housewife from Woodfibre, a Japanese National, signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 29th October, 1943. She would appear to have been evacuated, with her 2 children, at the same time as her husband (Keiichi, File 11713) on the 3rd May, 1942 (and not September 5th, 1942 as indicated on file) as their third child was born at Vernon on the 23rd May, 1942.


