

Information supplied by the R. C. M. P. showed this man to be the owner of a boat. Our vessels record revealed no vessel owned by the above Evacuee who is a Japanese National and therefore not eligible to be the owner of a vessel. However, the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee's card index of vessels shows the vessel "Great Bay", vessel No. 154,811 was owned by Zenzaburo ONOUE of Steveston but registered in the name of Usuke SHISHIKURA, File No. 2410. It is possible that Mr. ONOUE had an interest in this boat and this is the boat referred to by the R. C. M. P. Our vessel records show that this boat was sold by the registered owner and that the net proceeds of \$1,460.20 were paid to Saichi TAMOTO on April 11, 1942 on authority of Usuke SHISHIKURA.

No property interests other than those mentioned are found on this file.
