GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Jinkichi SUZUKI, Reg.No.09638

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on December 13, 1943, in which he stated that he owned no property of any kind left in the protected area.

No real property interest is revealed in his file.

The chattels dealt with in Chattel Schedule were reported to this office by the Britannia Mining & Smelting Co., Britannia Beach, under the registration number of Mrs. Jinkichi SUZUKI. Some of these chattels were shipped, at the request of Mrs. SUZUKI, to herself and her husband. The remainder were shipped from Britannia Beach to the Custodian, Vancouver, in June, 1945. The goods received by the Custodian have all been disposed of by sale, with the exception of two mattresses and these, being unsaleable, would be discarded. Proceeds of the sale have been credited to account of Mrs. SUZUKI, File 7924.

A camera, surrendered by Jinkichi SUZUKI, to the B. C. Police, is in Custodian warehouse, 604 Cordova. *Mailed to Suzuki November 27, 1946 JFM*


