



Takeji Toya died at Lois River, near Khartoum Lake, B.C., on May 31, 1941. He is survived by his widow, Hana, in Japan.

The deceased did not make any declaration to the Custodian and no information is available concerning his assets, if any. A box of Festival Goods was sold in the name of T. Toya at Steveston Auction No. 40 and it is possible that these might have belonged to the deceased but as the ownership is doubtful, the small sum realized, 99¢, had been transferred to Chattel Suspense Account.
