
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:



Mr. Tsubota was written to on June 5, 1944 regarding the amount claimed by M. Furuya Co. but no reply appears to have been received.


At the time he returned to Japan he had no credit in his account with this office and no action was therefore taken with respect to the above claims.
