Since the receipt of your October letter, new information has come to hand in respect to the PIONEER HALLOCH BOX CO., that was not in the possession of the Custodian previously. This may alter the distribution of funds arising from the assets of that Company, as well as other funds in relation to the Estate of your late husband.

In the meantime we are continuing our review of the various files and accounts involved, and in due course any funds that properly belong to you will be made available in the usual manner.

Dear Madam:-      Re:- PIONEER HALLOCH BOX CO.

In your October letter you state "I was the sole owner since my husband's death". Information has come to hand since the receipt of that letter that indicates that Haruo MACHIDA, Takeo MACHIDA and Isamu SHIMURA declared in their Dominion of Canada Income Tax Returns for the year ending December 31st, 1940 that they were Proprietors and Partners of the PIONEER HALLOCH BOX CO. The total net profit was represented as being \$2,734.10. It is obvious therefore, that the net proceeds arising from the liquidation of the assets of the Company must be held by the Custodian until this situation is clarified. We have written to these three parties inquiring if they did in fact own any interest or share in this Company, and are awaiting their reply.

You were advised in our letter of the 23rd of April last of the sale of the machinery of this Company and that the proceeds arising from same found their way into your account on our books because of the statement of your late husband in November 1943 that he was "sole owner" of this Company, which statement was contrary to the declarations above mentioned. This total net amount was \$1,973.39. A considerable portion of this has already been forwarded to you and therefore, pending the above required clarification, the funds of the TAIYO PRINTING COMPANY LTD. will be held here to cover same in the meantime.

A claim against the PIONEER HALLOCH BOX CO. by M. NISHIGUCHI Co. LTD. for \$212.54 has not been paid, and if correct will require to be deducted from funds on hand.

A claim of \$57.42 by M. FURUYA CO. is filed as against Shinichi MAEDA, Reg. No. 01864, former Manager of TAIYO PRINTING COMPANY LTD. He states that this account is payable by your late husband, and if correct will require to be deducted from funds on hand.

Dear Sirs:- Re: Your Claim-Pioneer Hallock Box Co.

Please refer to our letter to you of the 16th of April last, in respect to the above claim. We wrote to Mrs. Take MACHIDA on the same day, sending a copy of your letter and statement, so that she would be fully advised. We received a reply from her some little while ago. In her letter she says that she has gone over your letter very carefully, and that she does not recall any incident or any time that her late husband made such an agreement. She says too, "during the time my late husband was in business neither my daughter or myself was always informed as to any changes or any matter pertaining to his business". And "did Mr. MACHIDA draw up any agreement together with Mr. NISHIOUCHI pertaining to this said agreement. If so please forward us same".

We object to your now adding the claim \$15.57 formerly against Ruskin Box Manufacturing Co., to Pioneer Hallock Box Co. claim, as she says that this amount is recognized by her as against Ruskin Box and payable from the net assets, if any, of that Company. In this connection, we may say, that it is lodged against that Company for our attention when adjustment is made of claims against that Company.

In view of the position taken by her in connection with your claim against Pioneer Hallock Box Co. it would appear that we cannot do more to effect collection of this account, and would suggest that you contact her at the address given to you in our letter of the 2nd of April last.

No further action relative to this claim will be taken by this office, unless requested to do so by Mrs. MACHIDA, and in the meantime we shall consider the matter closed.

For the benefit of our file records we shall be obliged if you would advise this office if you have been able to reach a settlement.

Mrs. MACHIDA, as Administratrix, will in due course be receiving the remaining net funds arising from the Estate of her late husband.
