



Montreal, P.C. Don't Hadam:-Your letter of the 23rd ultimo, as also the previous letter referred to therein, has been received. This re ly is merely to savise you that the business in the custody of the Custodian in which you are interested, is receiving our attention, and a report is in the course of preparation, which will be forwarded to you just as soon as the material for same is assembled. Since the receipt of your October letter, new information has come to hand in respect to the PIONEER HALLOCH BOX CO., that was not in the possession of the Custodian previously. This may alter the distribution of funds arising from the assets of that Company, as well as other funds in relation to the Estate of your late husband. In the meantime we are continuing our review of the various files and accounts involved, and in due course any funds that properly belong to you will be made available in the usual manner. In your October letter you state "I was the sole owner since my husband's death". Information has come to hand since the receipt of that letter that indicates that Herus MACHIDA, Taxes MACHIDA and Isama SKIMURA declared in their Dominion of Canada Income Tax Returns for the year anding December 31st, 1940 that they were Proprietors and Partners of the PIONEER HALLOCH BOX CO. The total net profit was represented as being \$2,736.10. It is obvious therefore, that the net proceeds arising from the liquidation of the assets of the Company must be held by the Custodian until this situation is clarified. We have written to these three parties inquiring if they did in fact own any interest or share in this Company, and are amiting their realy. You were advised in our letter of the 23rd of A ril last of the sale of the machinery of this Company and that the proceeds arising from same found their may into your account on our books because of the statement of your late husband in November 1943 that he was "sole owner" of this Company, which statement was contrary to the declarations above mentioned. This total net amount was \$1,973.39. A considerable portion of this has already been foresrded to you and therefore, pending the above required clarification, the funds of the TAIYO PRINTING COMPANY LTD. will be held here to cover same in the meantime. A claim against the PIONEER HALLOCH BOX CO. by M. NISHIGUCHI Co. LTD. for \$212.54 has not been paid, and if correct will require to be deducted from funds on hand. A claim of \$57.42 by M. FURUYA CO. is filed as against Shinichi MARBA, Reg. No. 01864, former Manager of TAITO PRINTING COMPANY LTD. He states that this account is payable by your late husband, and if correct will require to be deducted from funds on hand.
