Under date of March 10th, 1944, we wrote Mr. Skinner requesting that he interrogate the above-named concerning the sale of her camera, now held in custody of the R.C.M.P., to a Mr. Marchi of Slocan.

It appears that her son, Shoichi Hayashi, #15930, a minor, wrote to the Custodian stating that he had sold this camera to Mr. Marchi and to forward it at an early date. He enclosed the R.C.M.P. receipt, which would lead us to believe that the transaction had the consent of the mother.

However, before we can consummate the transaction we must have written authority of the owner, Mrs. Sute Hayashi, that it has her approval.

Please, therefore, either obtain this authority for us from Mrs. Hayashi or find out her wishes in the matter.

Kindly advise Mr. Marchi as to the reason for the delay in shipping the camera.
