Our file indicates that on December 28, 1943 you requested Mr. Matt Brown of Cumberland to sell certain goods and stated that the proceeds should be held in trust. It was understood that the goods belonged to a Japanese Community organization. At a later date certain chattels were sold by public auction at Cumberland which appear to be furniture for a kindergarten or community hall. These funds are also being held in trust, altogether the amount being \$76.39, these apart from funds credited to your personal account from sale of goods believed to be owned by you.

Would you please advise us whether there was an incorporated society to which the school furniture belonged and if so to whom this money should be sent. If not since the goods appear to have been placed in your care, the Custodian will have no objection to forwarding the funds to you to be used for the benefit of the owners.
