P.O. Bridge River, NW D'ARCY, E. C.

On July 27, 1944 the above named policyholder forwarded us a money-order for \$47.15 in payment of the net premium due July 25, 1944 on his policy. It was discovered after an audit inspection of this branch in March last that this premium had not been accounted for and an investigation disclosed the fact that the money-order had been inadvertently attached to the official receipt for the premium which was mailed to the assured on July 25, 1944. Confirmation was received from the Post Office Department at Ottawa that the money-order which had been made payable to the Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada, had been repaid and that the signature to the repayment of the order at Shalath, E. C. on the 1st of August 1944 was H. Shiho. We wrote Mr. Shiho April 25th advising him of this discovery and requesting that he send us a certificate or return to us the official receipt which he had received. No reply was received to this communication and we followed this up with another registered letter on May 11th asking for an immediate reply but no response has been received.

It would be much appreciated by us if you would arrange for your representative at Shalath or D'Arcy to interview this man and bring pressure to bear on him to give up the official premium receipt to which he is not entitled in view of the action that he took in cashing the money-order.

We would be pleased to have your representative report to us the result of his interview with Mr. Hisashi Shiho in due course.
