Tsuya Nishimura died in the year 1936 at the age of nineteen years. He was survived by his parents, Jutaro and Shige Nishimura.

The only asset belonging to the deceased which has come to the attention of the Custodian was an account #N 1209 in the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Company. The Custodian learned of this in May 1942 when a letter was received from Messrs. Norris & MacLennan requesting payment of the balance in the account, amounting to approximately \$68.16, to the parents of the deceased as partial payment of funeral expenses which they had paid. The matter was referred to Messrs. P. S. Ross and Sons, controllers of the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Company, and on July 13, 1942, the sum of \$69.67, being the balance in the account of the deceased, plus interest, was forwarded to this office in the form of a cheque made payable to Mr. and Mrs. Nishimura, jointly. This cheque was forwarded to Messrs. Norris & MacLennan on August 3, 1942, and they acknowledged receipt on August 4, 1942.

No assets and no liabilities, other than those mentioned above, came to the attention of the Custodian.

We represent Mr. Jutaro Nishimura and Mrs. Shige Nishimura, father and mother of the late Tsuya Nishimura who died in the year 1936, aged 19. The deceased had a Savings Account in the Japan-Canada Trust Savings Company, the account number being N. 1209. There is another number on the Pass Book, 1356, under the heading "Home Safe Number." The last entry in the Pass Book is in February of 1937, showing the amount of \$68.16 to the credit of this account.

Mr. and Mrs. Nishimura on the death of the deceased paid approximately \$150.00 for funeral expenses and are anxious to obtain payment of the monies now on deposit. No Letters of Administration or Letters Probate have issued and the amount is so



Please be referred to your letter of July 21st. We have received a letter from Mr. Charles Reid, acting Manager for the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Company, in which he gives his opinion that the balance of Miss Nishimura's account may properly be paid to the parents of the deceased.

We quote from his letter as follows:

"We are of the opinion that the balance at credit of Savings Account No. N-1209 in name of Miss T. Nishimura (deceased) may properly be paid to Mr. Jutaro Nishimura and Mrs. Shige Nishimura, parents of the Deceased.

"We note that a letter from Messrs. Norris and McLennan, dated May 8th, 1942, addressed to the Custodian of Enemy Property, states that the last entry in the passbook is in February 1937 and shows a credit balance of \$68.16.

"The ledger here shows that the credit balance on February 27th, 1937 was \$45.38 and on November 30th, 1941, \$68.16. There has since been added .51¢ for interest and the credit balance is now \$68.67."

We would mention that Mr. Reid is an experienced bank manager, having acted as manager for the Royal Bank of Canada until his retirement and his opinion would be based on his banking experience.


