be advised that

- 1) they are a private Association belonging to Amalgamated  
Association of Fishermen of British Columbia
- 2) I am the Secretary of the latter said Association
- 3) I have issued a check amounting around \$16.00 in favour  
of Norris & Pratt and have same certified by the Royal  
Bank of Canada, East End Branch, Vancouver out of its  
fund. This check was dislocated since then and it is

Extract from Custodian's letter to Noguchi dated January 28th, 1943, taken from carbon copy on file 9067.

---

Norris and Pratt's claims unpaid, namely, \$30.00 - East Coast Trollers Association, which you say should be charged against the East Coast Trollers Association, but we have not heard from you yet as to who are the East Coast Trollers Association, in other words, who pays the account. we would ask you to let us have this information at your very earliest convenience."
