Disposal of Japanese Fishing
Vessels

fishing vessels, the duties of the said committee to be:

(1) To make such arrangements as will make it possible for the present owners of the detained vessels to freely negotiate for charters, leases, or sales of such vessels as they own to persons other than those of Japanese origin, provided that the committee approve of such charters, leases, or sales, which approval shall be a prerequisite for the use of such vessel under fishing license.
