In your letter of April 13, 1944, you stated the sale price of my property, viz:

or less of the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 14,  
Twp. 7, of the Municipality of Langley.

Veterans' Land Act to be \$1267.00. If that is the  
price of the property and equipment left when we were  
moved out here it covers only a part of the value.  
To build the 250 or so feet of chicken houses of that
