Received your letters dated March 21st and May 25th,
1944, also January 14, 1944.

I do not understand why the Custodian sold my property
at such dumping price. As you know those buildings were being
reconstructed for better revenue until I was evacuated at the end of
October 1942, and the revenue was very near \$1000 (One thousand dollars)
a month. The reconstructing expense was more than \$20,000 (twenty
thousand dollars) unsettled. Can you tell me what kind of protection
I can get from you to settle this matter for my protection.
